Noomi Rapace will receive the Progressive Lifetime Achievement Award during the seventeenth edition of the Rome Film Festival. This was announced by the Artistic Director Paola Malanga, in agreement with Gian Luca Farinelli, President of the Cinema for Rome Foundation and Francesca Via, the General Director.

The award ceremony will be held today, Sunday 16 October, at 19.30 at Sala Sinopoli in the Auditorium Parco della Musica Ennio Morricone, on the occasion of the world premiere of Django, in which Noomi Rapace plays the role of the powerful and ruthless Elizabeth Thurman.

The award will be given by the Iranian director and cartoonist Marjane Satrapi, president of the jury of the Progressive Cinema Competition.
