USEFUL INFORMATION

Ticket Office

Tickets to the Rome Film Fest may be purchased from 10 to 23 October 2022, online through the complete programme of the Fest website www. romacinemafest.it, or directly on the Boxol website https://romancinemafest.boxol.it (exclusively with the "Digital ticket" mode, the ticket may be printed or displayed legibly on one's own device).

The advance sales of individual tickets will begin on October 10th 2022 at 9 am, exclusively on the website www.romacinemafest.it, or directly on the website https://romacinemafest.boxol.it.

Each buyer may purchase a maximum of 6 tickets for each film.

During the Rome Film Fest, tickets may be purchased at the central ticket office of the Auditorium Parco della Musica (Viale Pietro de Coubertin n°30), which is open at the following hours:

October 12th from 11 am to 8 pm

From October 13th to October 23rd from 11 am to 11 pm Access to the ticket offices may be staggered to avoid gatherings; we recommend purchasing tickets online.

We remind you that tickets for screenings with paid admission scheduled to be shown at the Maxxi Museum, at the Cinema Giulio Cesare movie theatre, at the Auditorium Conciliazione and at Spazio Scena may be purchased on the websites www.romacinemafest.it and https://romacinemafest.boxol.it, or at the ticket office of the Auditorium Parco della Musica. Tickets will not be available for sale directly at the ticket offices of the venues listed above. Tickets for Teatro Palladium, Cinema Nuovo Sacher and AGIS-ANEC venues will be sold at movie theatres.

Ticket sales – DIGITAL RFF

For the XVII edition of the Rome Film Fest, a selection of events will be available for screening on the dedicated on-demand platform.

Starting October 12th, ticket sales will begin for the selected events, which may be seen on the website https://digital.romacinemafest.org.

Registration is required.

Discounts and concessions

Those who intend to take advantage of the discount rates granted to associated entities, must use the online ticket sales channels, entering the discount code provided by the concessionary Entity or Association.,The list of concessions is posted on www.romacinemafest.it.

Casa del Cinema

Access to the free screenings and activities taking place at the Casa del Cinema, open to the public and accredited visitors, are freely accessible while seats last. The list, the dates and the schedule may be found in the section Programma del Pubblico on the Fest website www.romacinemafest.it.

Red Carpet

It is possible to attend the Fest's Red Carpet in the Cavea inferiore and the Cavea superiore at the Auditorium Parco della Musica until seats are sold out. For security reasons, entrance gates may be subject to controls or staggered admission.

Access for the Disabled

Tickets for disabled visitors may be purchased exclusively at the ticket offices of the Auditorium Parco della Musica, upon display of official certification (Law 104). The person accompanying a non-ambulant person is eligible for a free ticket, while a 20% discount will be granted to the disabled visitor. For serious disabilities above 70%, there will be a 20% discount for the purchase of two tickets.

Other information

We remind the AUDIENCE that access to the movie theatre is allowed without exceptions up to 10 minutes before the beginning of the screening for all the theatres, and for security reasons, the entrances to the Auditorium Parco della Musica will be subject to controls. Suitcases or large bags will not be allowed into the theatres. We therefore recommend arriving far in advance to the entrance gates, to avoid any inconvenience. No one will be allowed into the theatre after the screening starts.

Failure to display a ticket will preclude access to the screening or the events of the Fest, and no refund will be granted. In all the venues of the Fest, seats will be assigned in compliance with current regulations. In

this regard, during the ticket purchasing process we recommend checking the accuracy of the number of selected seats, and recommended age restrictions. Any errors will be the responsibility of the purchaser and may lead to the impossibility of attending the event.

Children under the age of 6 will not be admitted to the Fest screenings. The programme will signal any screenings restricted for minors under the ages of 14 or 18 (respectively ages 12 and ages 16 if accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, both of whom must provide proof of identity).

In the theatre, cell phones must be rigorously turned off. Anti-piracy controls are in operation in the screening venues. It is strictly prohibited to make any audio-visual recordings with any type of equipment. Violators will be asked to leave and charges will be pressed for violation of anti-piracy laws.

Lost tickets will neither be duplicated nor refunded. Tickets may not be exchanged, unless the event for which they have been purchased has been cancelled by the Fondazione.

Any breach to safety measures or law and order will lead, at the discretion of the Fest, to exclusion from the Festival. The Fest organization reserves the right to take legal action against the participant for any damage caused by the participant themselves.

All the screenings will be in the original language with subtitles in Italian and in English or only in English for Italian films. Any exceptions will be announced. The Fondazione Cinema per Roma will scrupulously comply with the regulations of the Italian government in the matter of the Covid-19 health emergency. Therefore, should the dispositions in this matter be modified, all changes will be announced on the Fest website www.romacinemafest.it.

Rules for access to the theatres for Accredited visitors

Below is the information for admission to the activities of the 2022 Rome Film Fest for Accredited visitors. Like previous editions, the accreditation badge must be displayed for admission to the theatres, and seat reservations are required. Please read the information for the use of the Accreditation badge carefully.

To access the screenings at the Fest, accredited visitors must reserve their seat in the theatre through the Boxol online reservation system at https://romacinemafest. boxol.it/Accrediti. After entering the portal using their personal credentials, they may make a reservation, or cancel a reservation, or check their list of selected events. Reservations may be made exclusively online. It will not be possible to reserve more than one screening in the same time slot.

Badge-holders will be allowed to enter the theatre after their reservation has been checked by scanning the bar code on the accreditation badge, or reading the reservation email, which must be displayed with the accreditation badge.

The detailed programme of screenings for Accredited visitors is available in the following guide or in a digital format on the website or the Fest App **www.romacinemafest.it**, or directly from the Boxol website htpps://romacinemafest.boxol.it/Accrediti.

During the Fest, access to the Auditorium Parco della Musica and the spaces of the Cinema Village is free, but for security reasons, controls may be made at the entrance gates. We remind you that the red carpet will be held in the Cavea, with a reserved area for the press and photographers.

Starting with this edition, it will be possible to choose and reserve one's seat in the theatre up to the starting time of the screenings, if seats are still available. We recommend however arriving far enough in advance to complete all the security procedures established by the Fest. No one will be allowed to enter the theatre after the screening begins.

The accreditation badge is personal and non-transferable. If it is found in the possession of a third party, the Fest reserves the right to withdraw the owner's badge, and to exclude the owner from the Fest. The accreditation is valid for the entire duration of the Fest. The badge must be worn visibly and must always be displayed when requested by staff in every area of the Fest.

We furthermore remind you that in compliance with current government regulations, the use of a mask is not required, but it is recommended.

NOTICE: The health situation is constantly evolving and may require changes to the regulations and procedures to access the event; any changes will be announced in a timely manner in the event of further indications by the competent Authorities.

Corso Umberto, Rione Sanità, the Baths, the Mergellina station, the Hotel Oriente, the Prefecture, streets, corners, mostly deserted: Naples is in full lockdown. A spectral timeless city in the contemporary reinterpretation of Albert Camus' *La Peste* by Francesco Patierno, in which the feelings, the fears and the conflicts in the book slide harmoniously into the disorientation generated by the pandemic, and pieces of reality, such as the desperate man who roams the streets at night shouting, reflect the text. A hospital, its doctors and volunteers, the city officials, the tradesmen, everyday people, all mix with a crew making a film of La Peste, in a terse and engaging common drama. Some wish to escape. Some decide to stay. But fear cannot be confronted alone.

A man in a luxury hotel suite. A young woman knocks at the door. She is blonde and beautiful, dressed in a professional suit, and submits him to a formal interview. As the questions become more personal, the endgame becomes clear: Rebecca is a dominatrix escort. Hal her wealthy client, ready for anything, even to clean every centimetre of the bathroom in his underwear. But this is just the beginning of the new romantic thriller by Zachary Wigon, who has already worked on the black holes in the relationship between men and women in The Heart Machine. Closed in a room, Margaret Qualley (the daughter of Andie MacDowell and the hippie hitchhiker in Once Upon a Time in Hollywood) and Christopher Abbott (Piercing, the series Girls) engage with one another in erotic games, rebukes, threats, blackmail, they reveal dark sides, anxieties and fragilities, while the camera and the dialogue veer from the erotic to the noir. But everything, including the finale, is unpredictable.

Produced and magnificently acted by Jennifer Lawrence, Lila Neugebauer's debut film shows great sensitivity in exploring and portraying the way soldiers deal with the psychological and physical trauma they experience in war, as well as the difficulties, the misunderstandings and the suffering they seem to have endured in their previous lives, which led them to enrol in the army and leave for far-off destinations, where armed conflict is grisly and the future dangerous and uncertain. This is the story of a friendship that is not simple, but tender and real, against the background of New Orleans seen in a new light and the return of Jennifer Lawrence with a simple, minimalist but highly effective performance, which takes us back to that memorable *Winter's Bone* at the beginning of her stellar career.

This is something of a metaphor of the current situation in Algeria – where the Hirak, a powerful political and civil movement against the regime was definitively smothered by the pandemic barely a year after it was founded – the latest film by Mounia Meddur (Papicha), both entertaining and sophisticated, tells the story of Houria, a talented dancer who, after suffering severe physical harm following a seriously violent attack, continues her heroic resistance to pursue a dream that seemed impossible to achieve. To dance again, between *Felicità* and *Gloria*, in brightly coloured dress, on a terrace or on a beach, immersed in an ideal sisterhood of women who support each other, around a core of unshakeable resilience.

Digital sex crimes are rising rapidly in South Korea, where the victims encounter countless difficulties in pursuing legal action because of gender inequality and an inadequate response by the government. In addressing this issue, which has become of burning relevance, the young director Jeong Ji-hye, in his first feature film, tells the story of a middle-age factory worker, who moves uncertainly through the digital universe due to culture and inexperience, a silent victim of abuse and bullying in the factory where she works. Jeong Ji-hye's eye is sharp and empathetic, he captures the victim's fragility before the destructive power of cyber violence with great precision, but also provides an indelible portrait of a strong and unusual female character.

Two half-brothers, united by a father with whom they had a conflicted relationship to say the least, and whose funeral they must attend: Ewan McGregor (who plays an unusual role for him) and Ethan Hawke. Rodrigo Garciá, son of Gabriel Garciá Marquez, is a Colombian director-screenwriter, who made his debut as a director in 2000 with Things You Can Tell Just by Looking at Her (Un Certain Regard award at Cannes), and has often worked with Alfonso Cuarón (who is one of the producers of Raymond & Ray) and Guillermo del Toro. He has demonstrated a great capacity to reinvent genres (road movies, comedies, family dramas) and to construct characters you can fall in love with. Such as those played by Maribel Verdù and Sophie Okonedo, for whom Garcia shows himself to be one of the best directors of actresses in contemporary cinema.

In his first feature-length film, Filas Khoury makes a film (shot in Tunisia for obvious reasons) that speaks of universal themes (love, friendship, the fight against injustice, the search for identity, generational conflicts) in a context in which young Palestinians are denied their right to selfaffirmation by a tragedy that has lasted since 1948. Its power and originality lie in showing how the tragedy has become part of everyday life, and to bring to the screen (with great empathy, biting irony and a sense of paradox) a new generation ignored by the media, which proudly resists without ascribing to the logic of violence.

Fabrizio Ferraro, the director and screenwriter with a background in film sciences and the philosophy of language, chooses black and white to take us back into history, alternating wide-angle and close-up shots, intense dialogues and voice overs, interrupted by long silences and powerful static. A film that looks to the past to question our contemporary.

January 1991. Three aspiring filmmakers come face to face with an invasion of Soviet tanks sent to reverse Latvia's independence, declared on May 4th of the previous year. The film by Viesturs Kairišs, who was nineteen when he made it, not only reconstructs a generation that worshipped the films of Bergman, Tarkovsky, and Jim Jarmusch (courtesy of pirated VHS tapes of *Stranger Than Paradise*) and was hungry for the world beyond and a confrontation with history. This film speaks of the present and the unstoppable power of youth, and in so doing rekindles the freedom and enthusiasm of the Nouvelle Vague and the Nová vlna. Kairišs also pays homage to the charismatic figure Juris Podnieks, one of Latvia's most promising directors, who died at age 42 in 1992.

«Tell the truth»: this is the opening phrase of the new film by Cuban filmmaker Pavel Giroud, followed by a 1983 video clip from French television in which the host is interviewing Heberto Padilla, the poet and author of the collection Fuera de juego which brought him fame throughout Europe, but for which he was arrested and condemned by Castro. Back to 1971 and the black and white of the recording of his disavowal of his own work, on April 27th, in front of the intellectuals and friends, members of the Union of Cuban writers and artists: over two hours of recorded material which resurfaced fifty years later from a government archive, and which Giroud has selected and spliced into other materials that give a sense of the historical era. As Padilla, who theatrically crumpled up the text of the speech at the very beginning, continues his own abjuration, increasingly sweaty and histrionic, in a crescendo of dramatic Shakespearean cadences and overwhelming tension.

1941: Young Mendele is enthusiastic about working in film in Odessa, but returns to his native village ("shtetl" in Yiddish) in Ukraine, on the border with Poland, where the love of his life is about to marry the rabbi's son. And today is the first day of the Nazi invasion. The first-time Argentinian director Ady Walter uses the long take and black and white (even if the space-time continuum is interrupted by flashbacks in colour) as tools to plunge the spectator into the reality of a Jewish world on the brink of tragedy, between philological reconstruction and allusions to the present. The international cast all speaks Yiddish, including Saul Rubinek (The Unforgiven), who is acting in this language for the first time. The village was entirely reconstructed 60 km from Kyiv, with the intention of making it an open-air museum after shooting ended. The spelling of the title is a tribute to the novel A Void by Perec, in which the letter "e" vanishes entirely, to allude to a different void.

First narrative feature by German filmmaker Aelrun Goette, who first attracted international attention for her documentary *Die Kinder sind tot* (Prix Regard Neuf at Visions du Réel 2003). With its parade of photographers, models, new ideas and lifestyles, the film is based on reallife events, inspired by the director's own experience as a model in the late 1980s and early '90s in the German Democratic Republic. Straddling the personal and the public, sentiment and political conformity, it's a film that gradually turns into an energetic tribute to beauty and freedom. Filmed in 14 days, with few financial resources and a great deal of creativity, the latest film by Wang Xiaoshuai, one of the leading directors of the so-called "sixth generation" of Chinese filmmakers, is set entirely in a hotel in Thailand, where Wang happened to be on vacation for the Lunar New Year festivities in late January 2020. Unable to travel and to return to China because of the lockdown and the suspension of flights to his native country, the director decided - along with a group of friends, filmmakers, screenwriters and artists forced like himself into temporary exile - to make a movie. A meditation on the devastating effects of the pandemic, the film captures with surgical precision the sense of entrapment, confusion, apathy, growing frustration and sentimental instability we all felt during our days of confinement.

After his acclaimed essay films The People vs. George Lucas and 78/52 (on the shower scene in Psycho). Alexandre O. Philippe probes the ties between Victor Fleming's The Wizard of Oz (1943) and David Lynch's disturbing, fairytale universe. The influence of Oz emerges not just in the obvious places (Wild at Heart, Twin Peaks: The Return), but also in films with a subtler yet at times deeper link, from The Elephant Man and Mulholland Drive to Lost *Highway*. Our guides to the six sections of Philippe's film include John Waters, Rodney Ascher (director of Room 237), Karyn Kusama (Jennifer's Body, Destroyer), and David Lowery (Disney's upcoming Peter Pan & Wendy). In this journey into the American imagination and its recurring dreams and fears, Philippe was allowed to draw more freely on Lynch's films than ever before, making for some revealing comparisons.

The director of films about very different artists, from the present (Ferroni, Stagnoli, Pericoli, Ghirri) and from the past (Grunewald, Botticelli, Romanino), Elisabetta Sgarbi looks each time for the most effective device to bring the artworks to the screen. In this case she allows herself to be "captured" by the photographs of a master born in 1926, who progressed from a subtly surrealistic vision of everyday life to a dimension of experimentation and abstraction. And the film is not only an evocation of a method and a treatise on pataphysical techniques (polagram, lucigram), it also becomes the story of a romantic pursuit, between Migliori and his partner Marina Truant, which takes place entirely in a room opened by a musical score by Mirco Mariani. The author of films which have been distributed internationally such as *Il gesto delle mani*, which turned the rules of the "art documentary" genre upside down, Francesco Clerici deals empathetically with the figure of Milanese photographer Enrico Cattaneo (1933-2019): a unique photographer, who began his career doing photo reports, then fell in love with the artists of Arte Povera, becoming their trusted photographer, and then became an artist himself, playing with forms and objects. Sardonic and iconoclastic, Cattaneo smokes cigarettes in his house-museum-storage-warehouse, participates skeptically in retrospectives dedicated to his work, awaits with ironic resignation the end of a life and an era of which he was a witness.

A gaudy imperial villa instead of an obscure turreted castle; Apulia, from the Gargano to the Salento, instead of the Scottish moors; henchmen and bosses from the Sacra Corona Unita instead of generals, kings and aspirants to the throne. But the thirst for power, the homicides, the deceptions, the blood to be spilled then incessantly washed from the hands remain the same. In our tormented years, the Scottish tragedy, written by Shakespeare between 1605 and 1608, returns to cast its shadows and its prophecies (see the recent film by Joel Coen). Giulio Base (who also wrote the screenplay) rewrites it in a contemporary and viscerally Italian key, with a prodigious, sanguine protagonist and a carnal and deadly Lady Macbeth.

From Piedmont to Trentino, from Veneto to Sardinia and Sicily, a journey around an Italy that is changing yet remains bound by old habits, vices and virtues. Egidio Eronico uses only music and images to show the beauty and ugliness of the country, the environmental wounds, the fragility, and the desire to move toward a more balanced development. All this is encapsulated in a title that echoes the celebratory verses by Vincenzo Monti, Per la liberazione dell'Italia, yet also perhaps draws inspiration from the grotesque 1974 musical by Alberto Arbasino and Mario Missiroli of the same name. Luigi Ghirri was a great photographer whose art is explored not only through images (photographs and videos) but also through words in the film written and directed by Matteo Parisini. In fact, Ghirri wrote a lot, and the film looks at his work through those writings, read by Stefano Accorsi. And, naturally, through the places and the people who were dear to him: the Emilian countryside, the land, the water, the hills, and the endless horizons, which sometimes act as backdrops to everyday, tender and eccentric characters.

Sixteen years after *Quijote*, one of the greatest contemporary artists returns to the cinema with a film that is a cross between Inferno of The Divine Comedy and the tradition of the Neapolitan nativity scene, evoked by the joke from the play"Christmas in Cupiello's house": "Do you like the crib?" And just like in the nativity scene, there is room for some famous new characters (from Count Ugolino to Giordano Bruno), who are embodied in unpredictable ways through the masterfuluse of locations (sports fields, quarries, abandoned stations) and language (with Dante often translated into the Neapolitan dialect). Many guests (Francesco De Gregori, Toni and Peppe Servillo, Nino D'Angelo) take part in a timeless journey where, thanks to Maurizio Braucci's screenplay, it is legitimate to see the mark other famous journeys of Italian cinema, from those of Pasolini to those of Sergio Citti.

New Babylon: the city built on a crater and open to the derelicts, rejects and society's damned in Texas, around 1870. This is where Django arrives, searching for the men who massacred his family; and it is here he discovers that his daughter, who has now grown into adulthood, is still alive. Francesca Comencini (whose favourite films include Sam Peckinpah's The Wild Bunch) displays her usual grit as the artistic director (and director of the first episodes) of the 10-episode series, shot in Romania and conceived by Leonardo Fasoli and Maddalena Ravagli, inspired by the eponymous 1966 cult movie by Sergio Corbucci. Featuring an international cast led by Matthias Schoenaerts, Noomi Rapace and Nicholas Pinnock, this is a western that progresses from the desire for revenge and subjugation towards the need to start over.

La Paz del Futuro is a personal, political and artistic journey, that follows the figure of Janet Payone, the Italian-American muralist which joined the Sandinista revolution in Nicaragua in the 1980s. Almost 25 years after it was completed, Janet was invited to return to Nicaragua and together with Dan Hopewell to restore their most monumental work: the "la Paz del futuro" mural in Quiabù, on the military base of Estelì. With an ample use of archive material and new video, the film paints a portrait in motion (in space and time) of a woman who observes what is left of a series of murals and a revolution, offering a reflection on public art, politics and the passing of time: a look from the future to the past, and vice-versa.

In the mid-1070s, a generation had the idea that theatre could change the world. That period saw the rise of innovators who would go on to dominate the international scene over the following decades: Peter Brook, il Living Theatre, Jerzy Grotowski, Ariane Mnouchkine, Meredith Monk, Eugenio Barba, Andrei Serban, Giuliano Scabia, Dacia Maraini, Robert Wilson and Luca Ronconi, Ronconi, fresh from the international success of his Orlando Furioso and Orestea, was nominated as director of the Biennale International Theatre Festival in 1974. It's almost time to walk onstage. The doyen of Italian thespians stands up, makes his way slowly to the wings, appears to hesitate, then moves to the stage. The wait is over. On August 1st, 2016, in Rome, the legendary actor, playwright, and Nobel Prize winner Dario Fo is ninety and at the end of his career. The curtain goes up on one of his signature plays, *Mistero Buffo*, a revolutionary work censured at its debut. The film follows the actors as they bring Fo's words to life, and his play becomes a meditation on the human condition and the distortions of power, overcoming linguistic, geographical, and cultural differences. Fo's theatrical genius will work its magic one last time.

Drawing on the audio diaries of Louis Armstrong, the documentarian (a musician himself) Sacha Jenkins (Wu-Tang Clan: Of Mics and Men) revisits the music and reappraises the politics of the legendary trumpeter and jazz singer. Over the years, Louis Armstrong painstakingly recorded himself in audio diaries that reveal unusual sides of his personality: wholly original, unknown spheres of this very public performer, one of the most brilliant figures on the international music scene. An extraordinary series of period footage takes us back to New Orleans. New York, and the world at large. onstage, on the street, and at home, with his friends and family and superb musicians like Count Basie and Dizzy Gillespie. Produced by Brian Grazer and Ron Howard the film is a unique portrait of a jazz virtuoso, with a captivating soundtrack.

Donning a white mask and a bright red wig, her voice altered by a device. Laika (who took her moniker from the dog who space-traveled in the Soviets' Sputnik) has splashed the walls of Rome with posters and murals in the last two pandemic years. The images scream all of her civic indignation and include her best-known, the embrace between Giulio Regeni and Patrick Zaki. Two years of the mysterious street artist's social causes are tracked by Antonio Valerio Spera's camera in the dead of night, and Sperathrows in fragments of Laika's videos, interviews with recipients of her messages, archival material on hot topics of interest to the artist, and naturally, her works as well, serving up a spicy pop culture brew. It's all to revisit the last two years through the eyes and talent of a woman who calls herself a "Roman poster gluer" and displays a profound moral and artistic sensibility.

During World War II, for the first time, three American women became official photo reporters on the European front: Martha Gellhorn (1908-1998), wife of Ernest Hemingway from 1940 to 1945 and friend to Eleanor Roosevelt; Margaret Bourke-White (1904-1971), another legendary New Deal photographer; and Lee Miller (1907-1977), former partner of Man Ray and closely connected to the avant-garde. Luzia Schmid reconstructs three parallel lives by drawing on material often unseen until now, highly dramatic and visually stunning, mainly regarding the liberation of the lagers at Ravensbrück, Buchenwald, and Dachau, and the defeat of Germany. The experience left a lasting impression on all three, yet it was thanks to their eyes that the West began to conceive of war in a different way, shed of men's posturing and rhetoric: as a tragedy.

At times a frontier, at others a place to find one's identity; or a place to leave behind in search of new identities. La California is the countryside between the Via Emilia and the West, made up of so many microcosms interwoven into a genuine collectivity both visceral and ironic: Emilian. Written by the director. Cinzia Bomoll, together with Piera degli Esposti (the narrator, on her last film), La California mixes faces, types, and atmospheres and plays on the surreal ease of a community where, alongside the twins, the eccentric figures played by Nina Zilli, Angela Baraldi, Vito, Lodo Guenzi, Andrea Roncato, and even Chilean film legend Alfredo Castro can all co-exist.

Found footage from the late 1930s and early 1940s emerges from the basement of an English country house in 2021: two sisters. Mars and Thom, are behind it. Smart girls, they are. The first has filmed herself and her sister tirelessly, especially her sister's invention of a machine. LOLA, that can connect to the radio and TV of the future. Back then, the future wasn't only David Bowie, Bob Dylan and rock 'n' roll, but also the next steps in the Second World War, then underway. With very clever editing work and "dressing up" of the period footage on the part of director and writer Andrew Legge (on his feature film debut), as well as DoP Oona Menges (daughter of Chris Menges) and editor Colin Campbell, Lola, part dystopian comedy, part spy drama, gives new meaning to the mockumentary, with a nod to the Nazis entering London in It Happened Here (1965) by Kevin Brownlow and Andrew Mollo.

Bice Lazzari was a revelation to me. Going through her life story, I discovered a different view of the 20th century. I discovered the story of a woman who refused the place society wanted to restrict her to, a woman who survived wars and dictatorships, fathers and masters. Her whole life was one of resistance, without weapons or slogans but with brushes and canvases. She was an artist who had to deal with profound changes in her native Italy, and managed to earn her place in the world. Bice Lazzari is an icon of resistance. Telling the story of her emancipation was a unique opportunity for me to show the conflicts of the 20th century from the other side of the barricades, the female side.

Swing was his thing. In the '50s and '60s, Luttazzi wrote songs like Legata a uno scoglio. Rabarbaro Blues, Vecchia America (for the Cetra Quartet), Una zebra a pois (for Mina), and Souvenir d'Italie, perhaps his best-known hit: it even crossed the pond and was recorded by Perry Como. As well as a composer, pianist and singer of his own songs, Luttazzi was an orchestra conductor, actor (L'avventura by Antonioni, Weekend, Italian-Style by Risi), and a remarkable radio and television host. From Hit Parade and Studio Uno to Doppia coppia, Lelio Luttazzi was one of the most versatile and debonair showmen on air, to the tuxedo born, with a soul steeped in jazz and a well-honed sense of humor. Verdelli reconstructs Luttazzi's career and the miscarriage of justice that ended it in 1970 (and inspired Nanni Loy's film Why?). Above all, the film conveys the artist's charm and intelligence as he reinvented Italian music and entertainment.

What could he do during the lockdown? Confined to his studio, where over the decades he had created etchings, sculptures, animated films, drawings, and collages, rethinking the works as they took shape, taking them apart, fixing them, and correcting them, William Kentridge got to work. The South African artist films himself as he draws and often chats with another Kentridge in the same frame, with all the straight-faced aplomb of an expert comedian, in dark trousers and a white shirt. His life story and his career – his childhood in Johannesburg, the landscapes, apartheid and colonialism – will become the focus of a nine-part series in which the artistic process is constantly filtered through a thinking man's caustic irony.

Almost a self-portrait in the form of a portrait, and in the words of Jane Campion alone, taken from numerous interviews the New Zealand filmmaker generously agreed to. In them, she would range from autobiography to analyzing her own films, as well as accurately describing, with a smile, all the hurdles and prejudices women filmmakers have always faced in film, a man's world. Starting with that cinematographer who explained to the crew where he would place the camera, as if he were the director himself, and up to that group photo at Cannes in 2007, with Campion as the only woman among the winners of the Palme d'Or, who perhaps considered her a bit of a curiosity. Through photos, interviews, and above all images, glimpses, and the faces in her films, of both sexes, Julie Bertuccelli shows us a woman and a filmmaker who is not only an extraordinary, innovative artist, but also a very engaging, frank, and humorous human being.

A little-known story, swept under the carpet because it was inconvenient: the persecution and deportation of European Christians (Catholics, Protestants, Orthodox Christians and Jehovah's Witnesses) by the Nazi Regime, and the reasons behind it. Giorgio Treves, whose family survived the Holocaust, takes us on a journey in which he explores previously undisclosed archives and meets historians and Dachau survivors, who talk for the first time about what they saw and suffered. The film begins by shedding light on the ambiguous relationship that existed at first between the Church and the Nazis. deemed the lesser of two evils and a bulwark against Communism. But the destiny of the Christian religion, in the eyes of Hitler, was already decided, and the persecution of Christians (although lesser than that suffered by the Jews), according to many historians, was only the beginning of a new Final Solution.

What good is being Posaman? To save your hide at a party of mobsters if you don't know the words to neomelodic songs, for one. The mini-series by Eros Puglielli (who directed the duo Lillo and Greg in *Gli idoli delle donne* this year) starts with the most exhilarating comic character since Tafazzi, created by Pasquale Petrolo/Lillo for the game show *LOL-Chi ride è fuori*. This is the state of the art of contemporary Italian comedy, set in a sort of alternate universe, a wannabe Brooklyn that's more like Rome's Testaccio neighborhood. Guest stars like Paolo Calabresi, Valerio Lundini, Emanuela Fanelli, Corrado Guzzanti, and Maccio Capatonda add their takes on the undying art of improv with a hyper-realist slant that outgrows the transmedia label one could give it.

10th May 1981, Juventus vs. Roma at the Stadio Comunale in Turin. The league title is on the line. In the 72nd minute, with the score at o-o, Maurizio Turone of Roma scores a headed goal. Referee Paolo Bergamo allows it, but then notices that linesman Sancini has raised his flag for off-side and disallows the goal. The match ends in a o-o draw and Juventus go on to win the league title. Controversy abounds and the moment is watched over and over again in slow motion. A painful and still open wound. Turone's goal is the subject of this documentary by Francesco Miccichè and Lorenzo Rossi Espagnet, where archival footage and heated debates from the time are mixed with new interviews with Turone, Bergamo and Sancini, as well as Prandelli, Marocchino, Pruzzo, Conti, etc., to try and answer for once and for all: should Turone's goal have been allowed?

Until they all leave for Pakistan, where Lily films Shadaz's wedding, "arranged" by his family. Abandoning Elizabethan drama, Shekhar Kapur plays with identity, Oriental beliefs, western prejudice, unexpected loves, inspired by Jemima Kahn's screenplay, British celebrities in fashion, journalism, television, political and social activism. Result: a mix of Richard Curtis' comedies (*Four Weddings and a Funeral, Notting Hill, Pirate Radio*) and Mira Nair's Indian musicals.

As the opening credits start to roll, the score recalls that of North by Northwest, and there's no doubt a thriller (and a comedy) in the adventure of Philippa Langley, a middle-class history fan, who managed to put together and find funding for digs to locate the remains of King Richard III, then unearthed in Leicester under a parking lot. After Philomena, Stephen Frears and Steve Coogan team up again to tell this quirky tale of daily folly that could only be British. Sally Hawkins plays Langley as, after a night at theater, she starts to see the king in person outside her home or in the kitchen, and decides he wasn't that bloody tyrant Shakespeare described, and maybe not even a hunchback, and starts looking for his tomb. The archaeologists laugh, but laugh last: they'll join her on the hunt. This is Papal Rome in 1829, and the main character is one of the greatest leading men in contemporary cinema: Marco Giallini. Edoardo Falcone has stated that he loves Luigi Magni's cinema. Still, the starting point of the film he wrote with Marco Martani and Paolo Costella is Charles Dickens's *A Christmas Carol*. And working to change the mind of this Scrooge from Trastevere are no less than the ghosts of Giordano Bruno (Filippo Timi), Pope Borgia (Giuseppe Battiston), and Beatrice Cenci (Denise Tantucci). Reinterpreted by an eye that considers Belli's sonnets and Bartolomeo Pinelli's prints.

A simple and concise documentary approach leads us to engage with a film that addresses complex but extremely relevant themes: a delegate of the Red Cross and a group of Sudanese soldiers clash on their vision of war and conflict.

Rules of War, the new film by Guido Hendrikx, takes us to a country devastated by war, following the delegate of the Red Cross and former soldier Albert Schoneveld, who travels through war zones around the world to teach hardened soldiers the rules of fair warfare. Relying on a minimalist approach that allows him to clearly bring out the complexity and contrasts in the exchanges between the participants, Hendrikx discusses wars and their rules, seeking to focus the issue on the will of the parties to accept and follow them.

Wandering these rooms, hallways, salons lined with books is a lover, a collector and above all a reader of books: Umberto Eco in his private library. More than 30,000 contemporary books and more than 1500 antique rare books. Fundamental books, but also curious, eccentric, in some ways magical, cabalistic, bewitched. Eco devoured everything, including novels, which he swore he would never write, until that fateful year 1980 and The Name of the Rose (a best-seller translated into 47 languages and winner of the Premio Strega award). Davide Ferrario, who had collaborated with Eco in 2017 on an installation on the theme of memory for the Italian pavilion of the Biennale di Venezia, reconstructs the "Professor's" relationship with books, with the collaboration of family and friends, but above all letting the protagonist himself speak, caustic, biting, profound: «The totality of libraries is the totality of humanity's memory. Without memory we cannot plan the future».

A seventy-year reign packed with public appearances, as seen through the official portraits of Elizabeth II. Famed photographer Fabrizio Ferri takes on the queen's mystique by means of a script by author and journalist Paola Calvetti (based on her book), and the words, and above all photos, of the masters of the portrait genre, who found themselves face to face with the most photographed woman in the world, in her palaces, in studios, or outdoors. What that was like, and what they were out to capture on film - an element, a sign, an idea - the photographers themselves tell us, one by one, in front of the camera; or else Charles Dance, reads us the words of legendary court photographers no longer with us: Anthony Armstrong-Jones and Yousuf Karsh, plus Cecil Beaton, of the inimitable diary. Also musicianturned-lensman Bryan Adams. A regal figure with a sense of humor, says Julian Calder, who immortalized her in crown and ermine fur stole on the lawns of Balmoral.

Tel Aviv is the city that never sleeps, the start-up nation par excellence, the most secular and cosmopolitan of all Middle East cities. Its dynamism successfully merges the memory of the past with the unstoppable ambition of opening up every day to change, to challenge, to the future. The question is: Is Tel Aviv the avantgarde of an Israel to come, or is it just a little island – a "bubble" as they say – inside a country that is in perennial conflict with its neighbours and not only?

Two men stroll, large umbrellas under their arms, on a sunny day. They chat, they laugh, they walk quickly through Krakow, which was once the capital of Poland and that today, says one of the two, looks like Disneyland. There were 70,000 Jewish inhabitants before World War II, there are only a few hundred left. The two men have grey hair, are dressed casually and are respectively 89 and 83 years old, though they look like teenagers: they are Roman Polański and Ryszard Horowitz, a great filmmaker and a great photographer, who were childhood friends in that city and were later separated by the Nazi persecution of the Jews. Polański was hidden in the countryside after his parents were deported and Horowitz ended up in Auschwitz, saved by Oskar Schindler. Their memories resurface through the review of family photos, meagre and intense repertory material and above all, an uninterrupted dialogue punctuated by moments of laughter and surreality.

La Torre, politician, trade unionist and secretary of the Italian Communist Party in Sicily, was assassinated along with his friend and collaborator Rosario Di Salvo as they made their way to his office in Palermo. After almost ten years, a court reached a verdict on who ordered the killing: the heads of the Interprovincial Commission of Cosa Nostra. Three actors portray La Torre in different phases of his life, from his childhood to his support for the farm workers' movement to his joining the Communist Party. The film - partdocumentary, part-reconstruction - also incorporates interviews and archival footage, as Walter Veltroni, together with screenwriter Monica Zappelli (I cento passi, *Nour*), remembers a man who was determined to change the world and his country. "It's our turn" is a phrase La Torre used while speaking to Emanuela Macaluso just a few days before his assassination.

Starting with this symbolic fire, the stories of some of these workers come to life, as each of them is interviewed about his own personal history and "followed" across their days guarding the picket line.

A low-budget zombie movie, practically a Z movie, is being filmed in a dilapidated location, like an abandoned hotel, with a garish palette, all yellows and reds, and a single sequence shot with a hand-held camera. It's a onetake-only, that's a wrap! affair. Naturally, real zombies turn up, and they're hungry. The end. End credits. A series of flashbacks reveals the reasons for various bizarre inconsistencies. Why, for example, do Romain Duris, Bérénice Bejo, and Matilda Luz have Japanese names? Why does the camera occasionally try its hand at experimental cinema? Hazanavicius, in a pop culture parody vein, serves up a literal remake of One Cut of the Dead, cult movie and thesis film by Ueda Shinichiro in 2017, embellishing the original's zaniness with surreal French-Japanese touches and a sardonic nod at the chance nature of cinematic inventions.

For decades, the brothers Mohammad Saud and Nadeem Shehzad, self-taught veterinarians who believe in the interconnection between human and animal life, have taken care of the birds. This is a touching, hypnotic documentary with which the director Shaunak Sen, who lives in New Delhi, dives with Saud and Shehzad into their battle for change, which becomes a diagnosis of a city in disarray. Winner of the Grand Jury Prize for Best Documentary at Sundance 2022 and the Oeil d'or for Best Documentary at Cannes.

One day a ship with scarlet sails will come down the river to carry you away, far from here: this is the prophecy that a sorceress tells young Juliette, a smart, independent young woman whose mother has died; she was brought up by a strong-willed neighbor and her father, a World War I veteran. Set in the 1920s in a village in the north of France and loosely based on the 1923 novel Scarlet Sails by the Russian author Alexander Grin, the new film by Pietro Marcello in some ways takes its cues from mainstream cinema, while in others it displays an absolutely contemporary use of the medium. Gruff Raphaël Thiéry is superb (he recalls Michel Simon in L'Atalante), and the original use of stock footage here is practically a hallmark of Marcello's filmmaking. A history novel on film with its soul and gaze imbued in our own present day, Scarlet opened the Directors' Fortnight at Cannes 2022.

French, Spanish and Galician sounds shout, scream and fight in the soundtrack of the new film by Rodrigo Sorogoven, a filmmaker who is ferocious vet very human, edgy vet engaging. A French couple moves to the Galician countryside to practice eco-responsible agriculture and open a holiday farmhouse. The locals, especially the physically imposing brothers of the neighbouring farm, don't take to them. When the French couple vote against the installation of some wind turbines, hostility arises. In typical Sorogoven style, the outbursts are rare, but the tension continues to build: menace is suggested by aggressive looks and postures, and by the calibrated dialogue of a perfect screenplay; little by little, all the repressed frustrations rise to the surface until they explode into violence. As dark as May God Save Us, as tense as The Realm.

Of the films that have come out of Ukraine this year, this one by Maryna Er Gorbach takes place at a time and in a very particular locality: a small factory in Donbass, on the Russian border, in July 2014. A cowardly, selfseeking husband takes a servile attitude to the invaders, while his pregnant wife openly stands up to them, even after the Russians "mistakenly" destroy part of their home and bring down a Malaysia Airlines jet. Tragedies large and small. The worsening situation is shown through a lucid, neutral gaze, ironic in its bitterness, and the director displays formidable control over the story, as the award for best director at Sundance Festival attests. The ending is one you won't forget any time soon: shocking, yet offering a ray of hope.

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Louis Garrel has always fascinated and delighted audiences thanks to his light touch and his mercurial verve, all the while showing that he can inhabit characters that resonate deeply on a personal, real-life level, too. *The Innocent* is no exception. It's a romantic thriller, moving and joyful at once, that plays various themes against each other and straddles two genres, romantic comedy and action film. As in his three previous films, the actor/director draws on his own life story to tell that of Abel, who is opposed to his mother Sylvie's marriage to a prison inmate. The film is a romp bursting with joie-de-vivre, vaunting a stellar cast including Roschdy Zem, as the love-struck prisoner; Anouk Grinberg, and Noémie Merlant.

A highly visual contemporary waltz covering the life of the extravagant Empress Elisabeth of Austria, whose beauty and elegance are at the centre of this new film by Austrian director Marie Kreutzer. In 1877, the Hapsburg Empress Elisabeth 'Sissi' of Austria is about to turn 40, which, for a woman at that time, marked the beginning of the end. Trapped, as always, in the tight corset that imprisons her femininity, an angry and upset Sissi astonishes the court. Played by Vicky Krieps (*Phantom Thread, Bergman Island, Old*), and accompanied by a contemporary dissonant soundtrack, the film is a study of the anger and the fragility of a historical figure, as austere as she is mysterious, as rebellious as she is glorious. Vicky Krieps won the Un Certain Regard Best Performance Prize at Cannes 2022.

Valeria Bruni Tedeschi's sixth feature film seamlessly mixes the theatre of life with the physicality and creativity of the theatrical art. Delving into her own personal memories, the director returns to her beginnings as an actress in the 1980s at the modern and experimental Amandiers acting school in Nanterre, founded by Patrice Chéreau (Louis Garrel) and Pierre Romans (Micha Lescot). The film opens with an irreverent casting call to establish which aspiring young actors will be accepted into the school, to be trained by the legendary director. *Les Amandiers* recounts the passions and disappointments of a group of friends, from rehearsing Chekhov's Platonov to moving New York to study at Strasberg's Actors' Studio. Parties, tears, sex, love, drama, panic... theatre.

The Rome Film Fest returns to the Pope's Home for the Poor

The Rome Film Fest returns to the Casa per i Poveri del Papa, the Pope's Home for the Poor. Following last year's experience, Palazzo Migliori will again host a Rome Film Fest event, with a screening made possible by the donation of a video-projection system to the Home by the Roma Lazio Film Commission and the Regione Lazio. Palazzo Migliori is an aristocratic eighteenth-century palace that many thought should become a luxury hotel: but the Pope strongly advocated to make it a luxury hotel for the poor, because – as the Pope himself sought to

emphasize – the poor have a right to the most beautiful things. Since then, the home, owned by the Vatican, entrusted to the Elemosineria Apostolica and managed by the Comunità di Sant'Egidio, welcomes over thirty poor people every night, most of whom previously slept in the vicinity of San Pietro.

Interactions

Involving the artistic and film communities, the ONG ART for The World continues its commitment within the global initiative to bring greater awareness about the effects of climate change and the environment by producing a new series of short films with internationally-committed artists and filmmakers from all over the world. Interactions is an anthology of twelve films by twelve filmmakers: Faouzi Bensaïdi (Morocco). 
